PROGRAM SUMMARY & HIGHLIGHTS

The 2024 spring internship will take place at Woodward High School and will run from approximately January to May, coinciding with the athletics calendar. Interns will work 30-35 hours per week in a combination of office and gameday capacities depending on the needs of the department. Start/end dates are negotiable.
